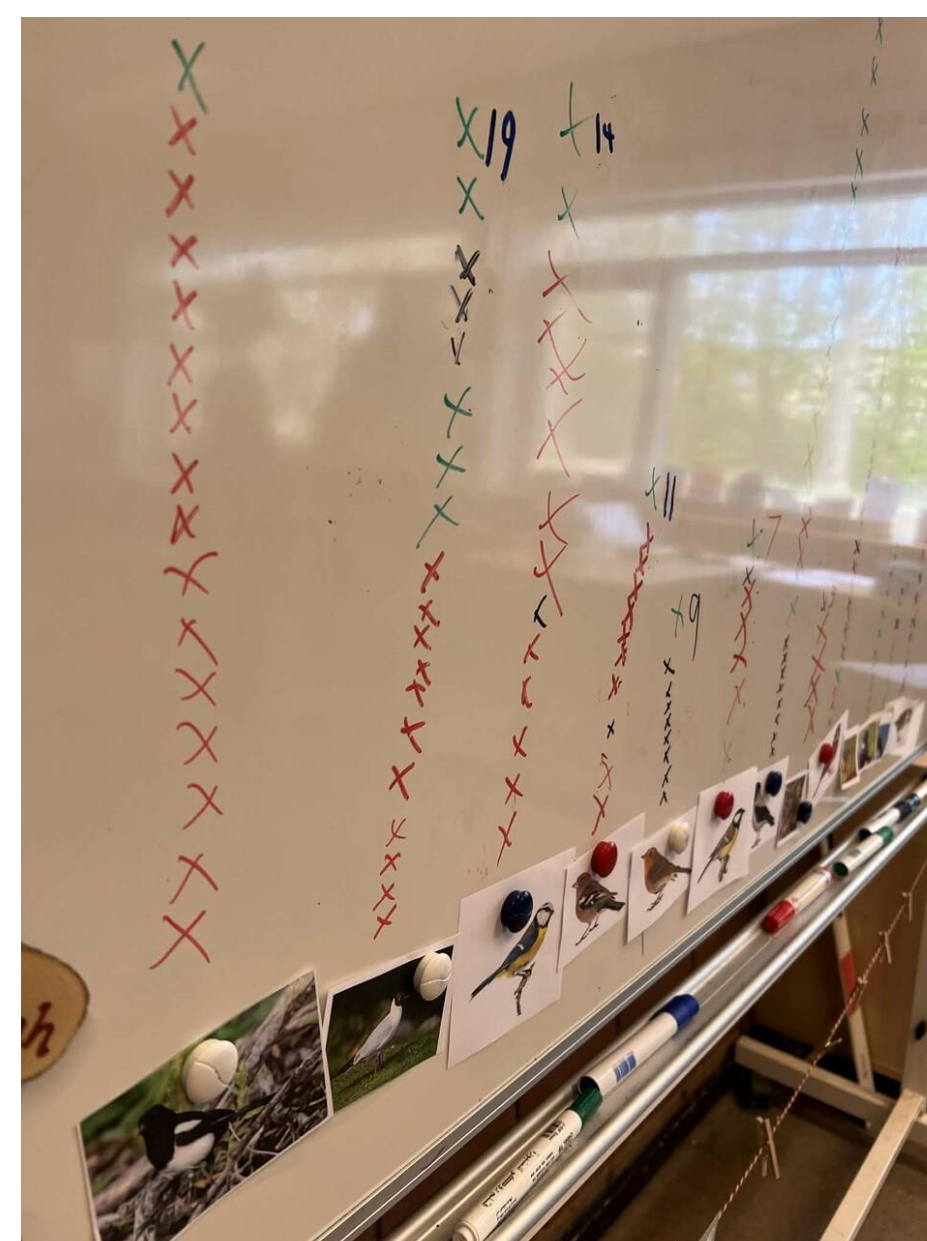
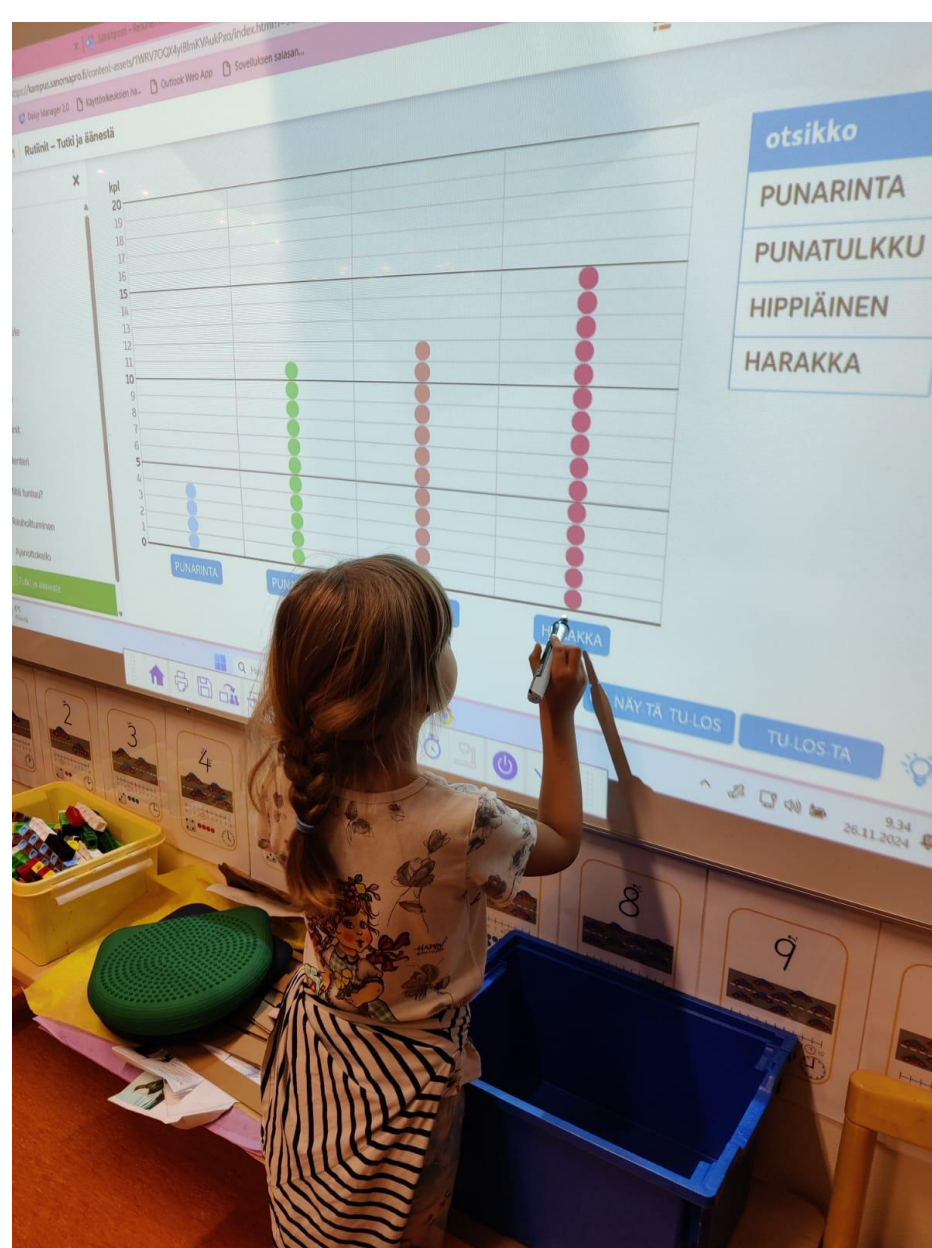
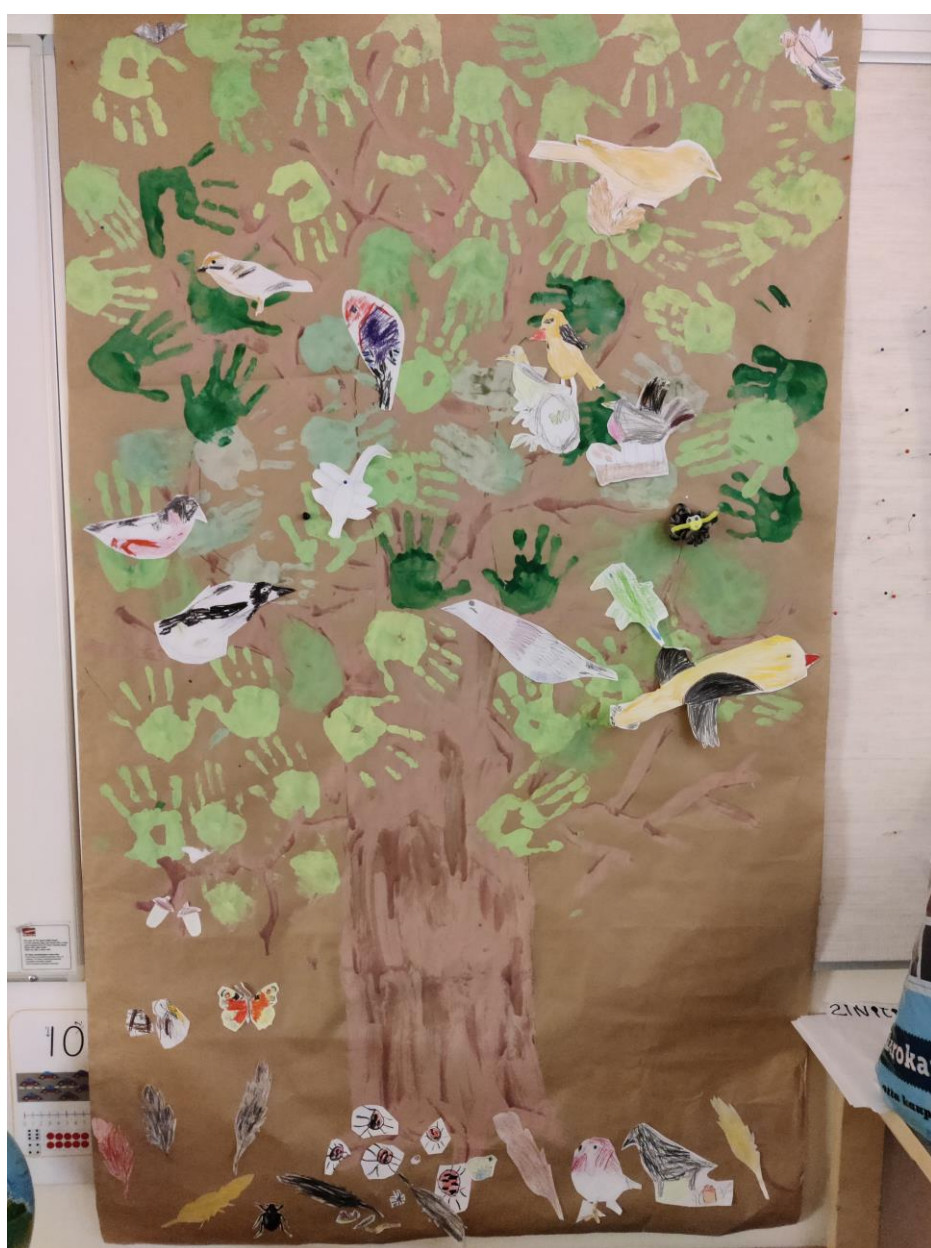

Young Birdwatchers Learning Together Across Borders

Children in Finland and Denmark observed local birds through the seasons by listening, watching, drawing and collecting simple data. They created seasonal trees, bird artworks, a giant nest and short films, turning observations into playful learning. Through photo exchanges, the classes shared discoveries and compared nature across countries—strengthening curiosity, creativity and care for the environment.



The project combined an eagerness to understand the environment with the children's own thinking and sense of wonder. Through the seasons we saw and heard different birds and get to know about nesting habits.
